

Business Enterprise

BTEC Level 2 Technical Certificate





The course is structured into 4 units. Units 1 the business enterprise environment is externally assessed and introduces students to what a business is and lays the foundations for the other units studied. It covers key business terminology as well as different ownership types and how they operate. Unit 2 is researching a concept for a new or revised product or service. It is an internally assessed. It looks at how enterprise ideas are generated and developed. Unit 3 promoting and financing an enterprise idea. Students will learn how to create a financial plan either for a new enterprise or an enterprising idea within an existing business. They will also consider budget costs along with estimates of revenue generated from planned sales. Unit 4 planning and pitching an enterprise idea is a synoptic internally assessed coursework unit which links to the other units completed. It takes the form of a practical project that requires learners to consider and select content that will enable them to apply their knowledge and skills from across the other units to develop a business plan and present it.
