



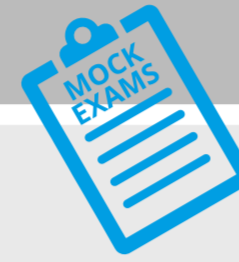

- Continue to work on revision skills and routines to ensure that the content of each topic is being effectively recalled on a regular basis.

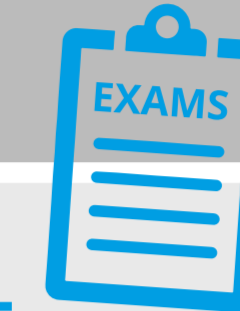
## Mastery in Year 10

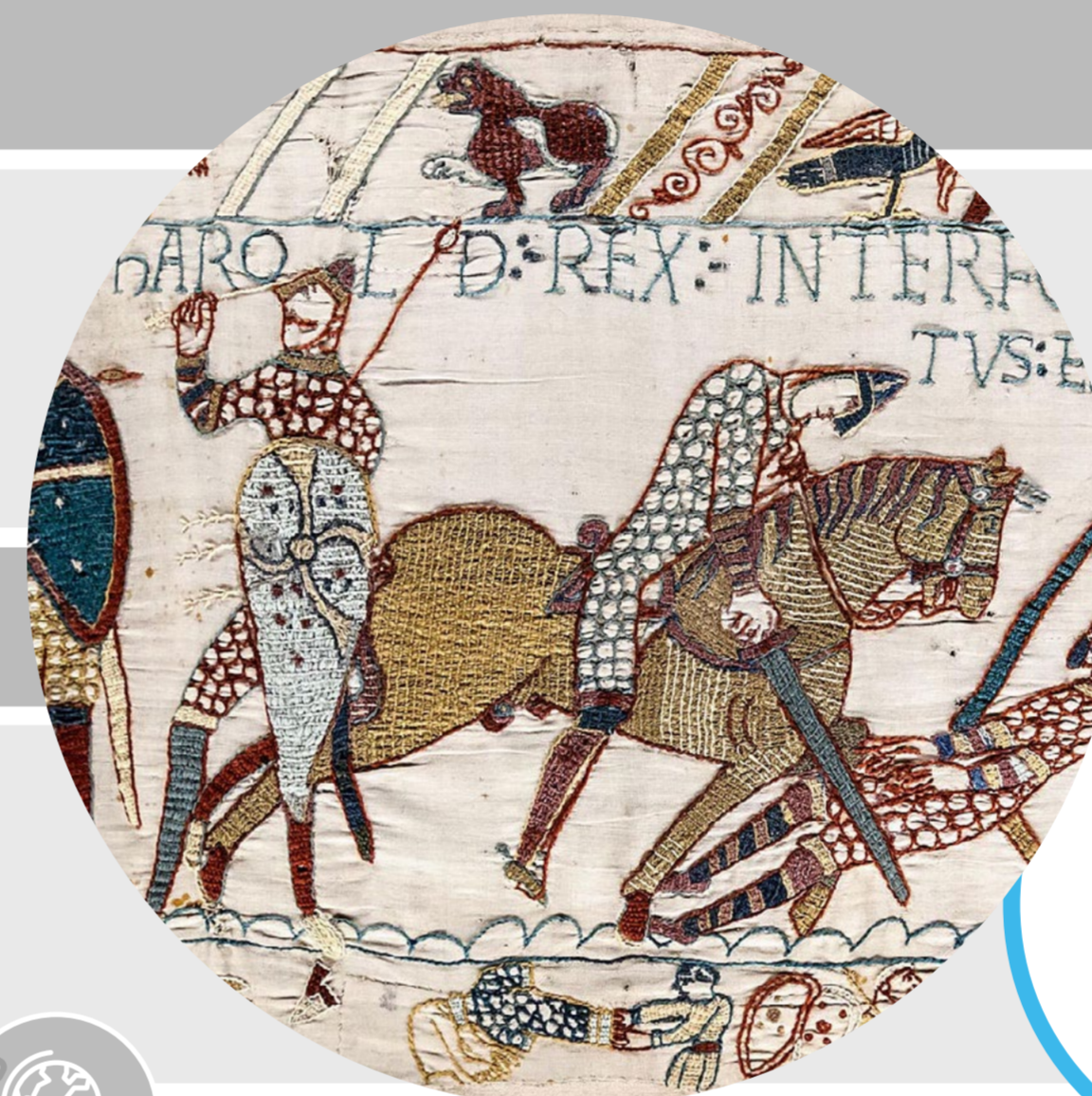
